Narrative of experience

There are many experiences I gained from TWINCLE Program in Chiba University, Japan. The experience is not limited to academic, but also includes cultural aspect. Firstly, laboratory work and experience helped me acquired knowledge related to Health and Safety Environment field of topic. I have learned about removing pollutant with activated carbon extracted from many types of natural resources, such as bamboo, wood, etc.

Secondly, during an activity so called "workshop on internship", I have learned the topic of Japanese students group to be presented in Indonesia. In September 2013, those students will come to Indonesia to teach the Indonesian high school students. In this program, we basically have to give critics, opinion, and suggestion about what is lacking from their material.

Thirdly, we have a cultural program, including the free time to visit several touristic places in Tokyo. In the cultural program, we visited the National Museum of Japanese History and Chiba Museum of Science.

Afterwards, the last program was the final presentation and farewell program on the day of our departure to Indonesia.

Impressions

There are many impressions I have, regarding to Japan and TWINCLE Program in particular. During the wonderful 11 days in Japan, I found that Japan is such a developed and civilized country in Asia. Moreover, Japanese people, in terms of character, are quite different than Indonesian people. However, compared to Indonesian people, Japanese are strict and not so expressive, although in general they are very friendly and helpful.
